



Graffiti in our Point Loma neighborhood

The Point Loma Association has recently received revised graffiti reporting information from the San Diego Police Department Community Relations.

If you see graffiti on *PUBLIC PROPERTY* (City of San Diego property) please call **619-525-8522**. This is a message machine. Call and report the time and date of your call and the location of the graffiti.

FOR EXAMPLE: This is John Doe. It is 10 a.m. Sunday, July 19, 2011. There is graffiti on the Northwest Curb line of the 2300 B Street in San Diego. It is on the sidewalk in black paint. Thank you.

If you see graffiti on *PRIVATE PROPERTY* please call the URBAN CORPS at **1-800-829-6884**. This is also a message machine. Leave the same message of time, date and location of the graffiti as in the example above.

The City of San Diego and the Urban Corps both have Graffiti Tracker (GPS based) cameras. These specialized cameras are being used to track graffiti vandalism around the City and County of San Diego. Please call the above numbers and report the graffiti. The appropriate staff will come by, take photos and remove it within 48 hours.

REMEMBER: Without photographic documentation there is NO evidence and NO case.
