Kudos to Correia Musicians!

Correia dominated the district's Solo & Ensemble Festival in February. Not only did Correia send the most participants of any school in the district, all the students received one of two highest ratings: Excellent or Superior.

At the CMEA Orchestra Make-Over Festival in March, Orchestra students performed for a small audience and Jung Ho Pak, conductor of Orchestra NOVA (previously the San Diego Chamber Symphony), who worked with the students and offered tips on how to improve as young musicians. Students then participated in master classes with the instrumental members of Orchestra NOVA.

Finally, it was the Jazz Band's turn to shine at the CMEA/City College Jazz Festival, where they earn a "Superior" rating. In addition, three Correia students earned "Outstanding Soloist Awards."
