4. Westminster Community Garden

The Westminster Community Garden (WCG) project is a "go"! It is located on Canon just to the North of the Westminster playground area. Soil testing is done and materials purchased. Most of the water lines are in, although we will be doing some more work this week. We will begin installing fencing this coming Saturday. At 7500 sq ft. the garden will encompass about twelve 10x10' garden plots and fourteen 10x20' garden plots, each with its own riser/faucet, a storage building with shared community tools, two composters (already built), and an area for tables and chairs for community events. The 10x20' plots can be subdivided into 10x10 plots, depending on demand. The Garden Manager, who represents the Westminster Community Garden on the Westminster Presbyterian Church's ruling session is Joe Meyer. Other members of Westminster plus one of my students, Bethany Tipton, constitute the startup Garden Leadership Council. I am functioning in an advisory capacity and am helping with labor. Later we will elect members to this council from the active gardeners in working with the WCG.
